NOTES:

1. PSYC101 or PSYC102 is a pre-requisite for all other Psychology courses, so take it as early as possible.
2. MATH106 (Elementary Statistics) is recommended *prior to* taking PSYC201.
3. The department recommends taking the Research Methods sequence, PSYC201 and 202, during the sophomore year, although the junior year is acceptable also. They do not have to be taken in order.
4. PSYC415 can be taken any semester during the junior or senior years, and can be retaken for credit. PSYC201 and 202 are pre-requisites.
5. PSYC420 can be taken either semester of the senior year. PSYC201 and PSYC202 are pre-requisites.

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4. PSYC415 can be taken any semester during the junior or senior years, and can be retaken for credit. PSYC201 and 202 are pre-requisites.
5. PSYC420 can be taken either semester of the senior year. PSYC201 and PSYC202 are pre-requisites.
6. Recommended off-campus programs: Chicago: Urban Studies, Umea University (Sweden), any MC sponsored program.
7. Off-campus study is recommended for the fall of the junior year, but can be scheduled at other times. If you are interested in studying off-campus for a semester, be sure to take PSYC201 and PSYC202 in the sophomore year in order to make scheduling in your junior year more flexible.

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
