PURPOSE

The main reason for this scholarship is to help with the cost of an education at Monmouth College and to encourage young men who exemplify the principles which the fraternity sees as paramount qualities in aspiring leaders. This scholarship will be awarded to the recipient the committee chooses based on leadership potential and our three cardinal principles: friendship, sound learning, and moral rectitude. This scholarship is open to any incoming student. A recipient does not need to join Phi Delta Theta to accept the scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Phi Delta Theta Illinois Gamma awards this scholarship on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and the interview. Phi Delta Theta pays scholarship funds directly to Monmouth College. Scholarships are awarded at the beginning of the academic year. This scholarship will only be awarded to new incoming students and cannot be renewed. The Robert “Bob” Stenander Scholarship is awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, religion, or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be an incoming student at Monmouth College.
- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum un-weighted cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at Monmouth College for the upcoming academic semester. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only school that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant.
- Transfer and international students are eligible for this scholarship.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by Wednesday, September 7, 2016.

APPLICATION PROCESS

TIMELINE

- New applications are due **Wednesday September 7, 2016.**
- Candidates who are eligible for interviews will be notified by the Scholarship Committee.
- Applicants will be notified to let them know if they have been selected for the scholarship or not.
- Interviews will take place over the phone or in person depending on the availability of the applicant.

NEW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official high school transcript in a sealed envelope from the institution.
- One reference from a guidance counselor, teacher, academic mentor, or community member.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Recipients of this award **are not required** to join Phi Delta Theta, but they are encouraged to consider one of the outstanding fraternities on campus.

Deadline for the application is Wednesday September 7, 2016. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
